MESSAGE APPLICATION Guide

Start with an icebreaker question to get everyone talking, then choose the questions that work best for your group.

He's Still* Got the Whole World in His Hands Week 3

ICE-BREAKER:

What is the difference between the hope of a Christian and wishful thinking?

DISCUSS:

What are some of the walls (either a thing or a person) you've leaned your ladder of hope against, only to discover they are not stable or secure?

If we define hope as "the optimistic expectation of a positive outcome", how can people maintain hope in a world that seems hopelessly broken today?

In the midst of all the uncertainty in the world we are living in, how confident are you that your ladder is leaning against something that is stable and secure? How do you know?

READ: "Let your unfailing love surround us, LORD, for our hope is in you alone."
- Psalm 33:22 (NLT)

How would an outside observer know that you have placed your hope in the Lord?

APPLICATION:

Think about who needs to hear about this hope - what would you say to encourage them to put their hope in the Lord?

How do you intend to remain hopeful in a hopelessly broken world?

Do you truly believe God's got the whole world in His hands? What evidence can you provide to support your claim?
