The Best “Yes” in the Bible

ICE-BREAKER:

Do you remember a time when someone showed up unexpectedly to surprise you? Share what that experience was like.

DISCUSS:

One out of 30 verses in the Bible talk about the return of Jesus. Why do you think it is such a prominent subject in the Bible?

READ: *“He who is the faithful witness to all these things says, ‘Yes, I am coming soon!’ Amen! Come, Lord Jesus!”* **Revelation 22:20 (NLT)**

The last words of anyone are often significant. Because these are the last words of Jesus recorded of our Bible, how does that change your perspective on what should be a priority for us if we are followers of Jesus?

Jesus didn’t tell us exactly when He would come back. In fact, He said it’s not for us to know (Acts 1:7). Why do you think He didn’t want us to know?

READ: *“Don’t let your hearts be troubled. Trust in God, and trust also in me. There is more than enough room in my Father’s home. If this were not so, would I have told you that I am going to prepare a place for you? I will come and get you, so that you will always be with me where I am.”* **John 14:1-3 (NLT)**

How do these verses provide hope and comfort in our troubled world?
