### One Another Week 5

#### ICE-BREAKER:

Unity in some relationships seems to take a lot of work. Why does disunity sometimes seem to be so much easier?

#### DISCUSS:

Tell about a time when unity was restored in an important relationship in your life. What happened to make this restoration possible?

#### READ:

*"I pray that they will all be one, just as you and I are one—as you are in me, Father, and I am in you. And may they be in us so that the world will believe you sent me. I have given them the glory that you gave me, that they may be one as we are one—May they experience such perfect unity that the world will know that you sent me and that you love them as much as you love me."*
